The following dates are dependent upon the date of finalization of the review and approval of the map and boundary description by the Assessor's Mapping Department. As per state law, we must send a notice of protest hearing to all landowners within the territory to be annexed. Therefore, we need an accurate list of landowners to ensure the protest hearing is properly noticed. That list comes from the Assessor. I have spoken with the manager there and they are aware of the project but have not received the documents as of yet.

February 5th – 1st hearing on the proposal. Commission either approves, approves with conditions or denies reorganization.

February 10th to 14 – If we have received the final list of landowners from the Assessor, we will prepare and mail out the Notice of Protest Hearing and Protest forms. Protest period is from the date of the Notice of Hearing to the close of the Protest Hearing.

April 2 or May 7 – Protest Hearing at which the protests are counted. If the landowner list is delayed, the Protest Hearing will be held in May to allow for a sufficient protest period.

April 2nd to May 2nd or May 7th to June 6th – 30-day reconsideration period during which the Commission may not take any action.

After the expiration of the reconsideration period, the Certificate of Completion, map, legal boundary description and Commission Resolutions may be recorded, and the reorganization finalized.
